1	<p>Can the manpower of Student Wellness be combined with that of the District Health Centre (DHC) in the future?</p> <p>Organizations may propose the operation plan and manpower in Schedule 3 for consideration.</p>
2	<p>Will the outreach team premises be included as part of the site for the future Wan Chai DHC?</p> <p>The Government will provide a site in Wan Chai District with part of the area to support the outreach service.</p>
3	<p>Will the Sport Health programme cover all 6,000 students, or only school teams?</p> <p>The 6,000 headcounts per annum is for the three mandatory services, which will be provided to secondary day school students studying in Wan Chai District and / or nearby districts.</p>
4	<p>Will the Government provide the site?</p> <p>The site will be provided by the Government.</p>
5	<p>Can we provide comprehensive and sports medicine clinical assessments through purchasing of laboratory services?</p> <p>Organizations may propose the operation plan and the corresponding estimated cost in the relevant parts of Schedules 2, 3, 4 and 5 for consideration.</p>
6	<p>Regarding the IT platform, if an overseas service provider is used, is it allowed to store data on overseas servers?</p> <p>Organizations may propose the related plan and the corresponding estimated cost in the relevant parts of Schedules 4 and 5 for consideration.</p>
7	<p>Are there any boundaries for nearby districts adjacent to Wan Chai, as it is an outreach services for secondary schools?</p> <p>Organization may propose the specific boundary coverage in Schedule 5 for consideration.</p>
8	<p>Are there any specific points that require attention for the operation of the DHC, or will it be similar to other DHCs?</p> <p>DHC is not covered in this EOI exercise. Relevant information will be provided in tender document later.</p>

9	<p>What are the differences between organisations that have submitted EOI and those that have not?</p> <p>There is no difference between those organisations that have submitted EOI and those that have not. Organizations are encouraged to submit EOI with their comments and proposal.</p>
10	<p>Will the tender include a full-time service component that covers both DHC operations and Student Wellness outreach services for secondary school students?</p> <p>It is intended that the Outreach Service for Secondary School Student Wellness will be included in the tender for provision of services to operate a DHC. For details, please refer to tender document later.</p>
11	<p>Will the future Wan Chai DHC and secondary school outreach services be combined in a single tender, or will they be issued as separate tenders?</p> <p>It is intended that the Outreach Service for Secondary School Student Wellness will be included in the tender for provision of services to operate a DHC. For details, please refer to tender document later.</p>
12	<p>Will the contracts be awarded to two different NGOs? What will be the marking criteria?</p> <p>Organizations may indicate in Part A of Schedule 2 whether they can provide services for both DHC and Outreach Service or either one.</p>
13	<p>Will the successful rate be affected if an organisation only submits a bid for only one part?</p> <p>Organizations may indicate in Part A of Schedule 2 whether they can provide services for both DHC and Outreach Service or either one.</p>
14	<p>Can one more organizations jointly bid for the EOI?</p> <p>Organizations may indicate in Part A of Schedule 2 whether they can provide services for both DHC and Outreach Service or either one.</p>
15	<p>There is already a DHCE in Wan Chai, will it be upgraded to a DHC, or will the existing DHCE be retained while a new DHC is established?</p> <p>DHC is not covered in this EOI exercise. Relevant information will be provided in tender document later.</p>
